SEASON TICKET & PARKING POLICIES

HOW IT WORKS

Your Razorback Foundation Annual Fund membership level determines how many season tickets, parking passes, and which specific sections within each athletic venue you qualify for.

- To retain your season tickets and parking, you must meet or exceed your previous year's Annual Fund contribution.
- Membership requirements for all sections, parking lots, and season ticket limits are subject to change on a year-to-year basis and without notice.
- All season ticket and parking inventory is based upon availability each year. Giving at the minimum membership level requirement for specific sections or parking lots does not guarantee tickets or parking in those locations.
- The Razorback Foundation or Razorback Ticket Center reserves the right to hold your tickets until all balances for both parties are paid in full.

SEATING AND PARKING REMOVAL/RELOCATION

Seating and parking for all sports are subject to removal or relocation if:

- Annual fund contribution is not maintained
- Any renewal or payment deadlines are not met
- There is an outstanding balance from the previous year
- Renovations or construction projects
- A reseating or reparking process is communicated for any sport.

ADDING OR CHANGING SEASON TICKETS AND PARKING

SEATING

- Football, Men's Basketball, and Baseball: The opportunity to move current season ticket locations or purchase new season tickets will be during the annual seat selection process for each sport.
- Olympic and Women's Sports: To move current season ticket locations or purchase new season tickets, please contact the Razorback Ticket Center by calling 479-575-5151 or emailing raztk@uark.edu.

PARKING

- Football and Men's Basketball: The opportunity to move current parking pass locations or to secure new parking will be during the annual seat selection process for each sport.
- Baseball, Olympic, and Women's Sports: To move current parking pass locations or to secure new parking, please contact the Razorback Foundation by calling 479-443-9000 or emailing gohogs@razorbackfoundation.com

ACCOUNT TRANSFERS AND MERGERS

- Razorback Foundation members may submit a request to transfer their season tickets or merge their account to immediate family members only (parents, current spouse, children, or siblings). The request must be submitted in writing to the Razorback Foundation.
- To retain the same seating, the new account holder must increase to the required annual fund membership level OR maintain the current account holder's contribution if the required membership level is already being met.
- Suites, loge boxes, and parking are not eligible for transfer.
- Requests to account name changes of any kind are subject to the same policies.



PRIORITY POINTS

The Razorback Priority Points Program is designed to recognize our members' commitment to Razorback Athletics, honoring and rewarding their generous financial support, loyalty and passion over the years. The program encourages consistency and transparency in the allocation of member benefits, tickets and parking by assigning point values to several categories of giving to the Razorback Foundation. The points from each giving category are combined, then used to rank each member within their Annual Fund membership level.

ANNUAL FUND MEMBERSHIP CLASS AND RANK WITHIN EACH CLASS WILL DETERMINE HOW THE FOLLOWING BENEFITS ARE ALLOCATED:

- New/Additional Season Tickets
- Season Parking Passes
- Suites and Loge Boxes
- Season Ticket and Parking Selection Process Appointment Times
- Away/Neutral Site Game Tickets
- Postseason Tickets (Bowl Games, SEC and NCAA Tournaments, College World Series, etc.)
- Other Razorback Foundation Benefits

PRIORITY POINTS ARE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

1 Point for every \$100 received - All Gifts (Annual Fund gifts, Capital gifts, ONE Razorback Fund gifts, event sponsorships, etc.)

5 Points for every consecutive year of giving to the Annual Fund

25 Points former Razorback Student-Athlete - allocated one time

2X points for Capital gifts of \$50,000-\$99,999

3X points for Capital gifts of \$100,000 or more



FOOTBALL PREMIUM SEATING

CLUB SEATING

- Razorback Stadium has 6 different club areas for fans to choose from that provide outdoor and indoor seating options, premium food and drinks, and other amenities to enhance their game day experience.
- The Big Hog membership level (\$500+ annually) is required to qualify for club seating in addition to the cost of season tickets which varies by each club area.

OUTDOOR CLUB SEATING

- **East Outdoor Club** - East Sideline
- **Cardinal Club** - South End Zone
- **SEC Club** - North End Zone
- **Touchdown Club** - North End Zone

INDOOR CLUB SEATING

- **Diamond Club** - South End Zone
- **Capital Club** - East Sideline



SUITES

- Razorback Stadium is home to 172 suites that are sold on a full season basis only to Razorback Foundation members.
- Cost varies by the location and size of each suite. Suites range from 10-22 tickets.
- Suites are allocated as availability allows on a year-to-year basis by Razorback Foundation membership level and priority point ranking to members on a wait list.

LOGE BOXES

- Loge Boxes provide fans with a semi-private seating experience without missing any of the in-game excitement.
- There are 70 loge boxes inside Razorback Stadium, located at both the field level and second level of the North end zone.
- Each Loge box comes with four (4) seats, all inclusive food and beverage, and access to an indoor club area.
- Loge Boxes are allocated as availability allows on a year-to-year basis by Razorback Foundation membership level and priority point ranking to members on a wait list.

FOOTBALL PARKING

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR FOOTBALL PARKING

Be a current Football season ticket holder.

Donate \$750+ to the Razorback Foundation Annual Fund.

PARKING PASS ALLOCATIONS

Parking can be selected as availability allows during the annual Seating and Parking selection process that takes place each Spring

Any Razorback Foundation member that qualifies for parking and purchases season tickets after the selection process will be able to select a parking lot based upon:

- Current membership level.
- Total priority points within your membership level.
- Availability in all parking lots that you are eligible for based upon your membership level.

PARKING PASS LIMITS

Season ticket holders are eligible for one (1) parking pass for every five (5) season tickets purchased, up to the maximum number of parking passes that their membership level qualifies them for.

Prior to the 2025-26 men's basketball season, all seating inside Bud Walton Arena will be reset, marking the first comprehensive reseat since the arena opened in 1993.

TO TAKE PART IN THE PROCESS, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2025 Annual Fund Member of the Razorback Foundation by June 30th, 2025.
- Submitted the required ticket request form by June 30th, 2025.

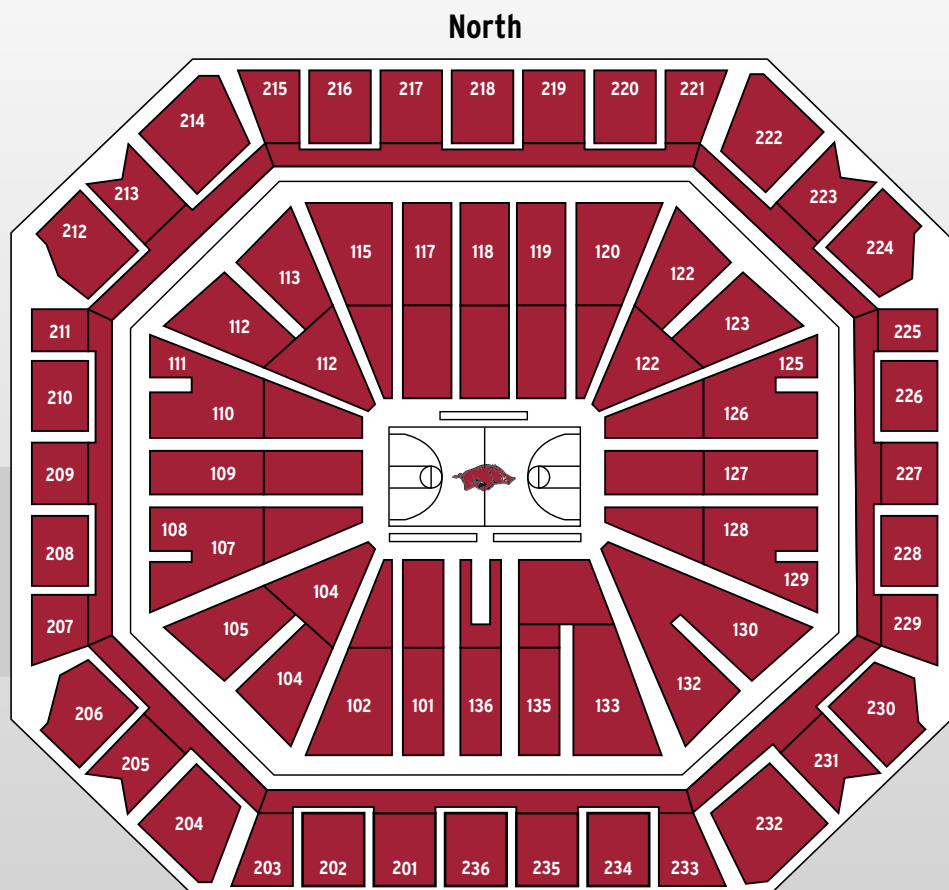

SEASON TICKETS

- The best opportunity to secure new Men's Basketball season tickets is during the annual online selection process that takes place in August.
- Following the 2025-2026 reseat process, season tickets will be eligible for renewal on a year to year basis.
- In order to renew Men's Basketball season tickets, you must meet or exceed the annual fund contribution you were donating when you acquired your season tickets.
- Donating at a certain membership level does not guarantee tickets in a specific/desired area of Bud Walton Arena as it is all based on available inventory.
- All sections, ticket limits, and membership requirements are subject to change on a year-to-year basis and without notice.

SUITES

Bud Walton Arena has 42 suites that are sold on a full season basis only to Razorback Foundation members.

Annual Membership Level Requirement To Qualify:
Broyles-Matthews Diamond (\$40,000+)

- Cost of suite tickets vary by the location and size of each suite.
- Suites are allocated as availability allows on a year-to-year basis by Razorback Foundation membership level and priority point ranking to eligible members on a wait list.

COURTSIDE SEATING

Bud Walton Arena has courtside seats on the sidelines and baselines of Nolan Richardson Court.

All courtside seating is sold on a full-season basis only to Razorback Foundation members that qualify.

Annual Membership Level Requirement To Qualify:
Broyles-Matthews Diamond (\$40,000+)

- The cost of tickets vary by location and a maximum of four (4) courtside seats are allowed per account.
- Courtside seat holders have access to the Courtside Club where all inclusive food and beverages are offered.
- Courtside seats are allocated as availability allows on a year to year basis by Razorback Foundation membership level and priority point ranking to eligible members on a wait list.

MEN'S BASKETBALL PARKING

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR MEN'S BASKETBALL PARKING

- Be a current Men's Basketball season ticket holder.
- Donate \$500+ to the Razorback Foundation Annual Fund.

PARKING PASS ALLOCATIONS

Like the seating inside Bud Walton Arena, all parking assignments will be reset prior to the 2025-26 season.

Parking can be selected based on availability at your assigned appointment time during the selection process that will take place in August.

PARKING PASS LIMITS

Season ticket holders are eligible for one (1) parking pass for every five (5) season tickets purchased, up to the maximum number of parking passes that their membership level qualifies them for.

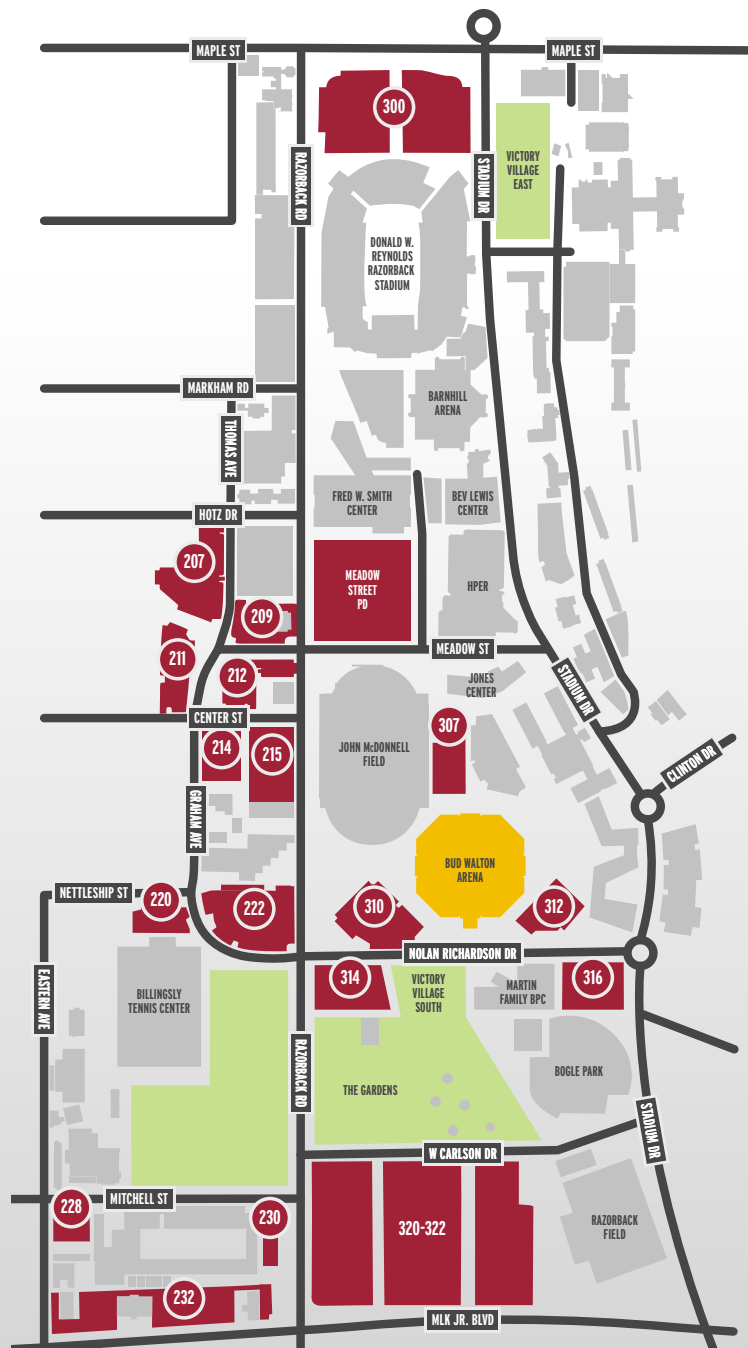

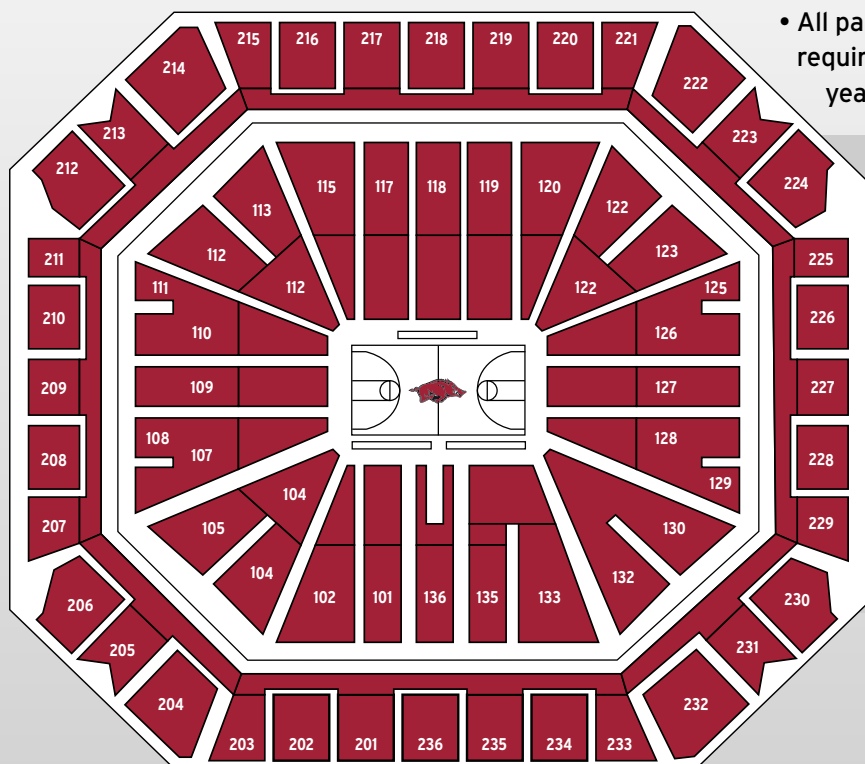
WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TICKETS & PARKING

SEASON TICKETS

- Women's Basketball season tickets are eligible for renewal each year. The process tentatively takes place annually in June.
- To retain Women's Basketball season tickets in reserved or courtside seat sections, existing season ticket holders must maintain or exceed the previous year's total Annual Fund contribution.
- All sections, ticket limits, and membership requirements are subject to change on a year-to-year basis and without notice.
- New Women's Basketball season ticket sales begin during the summer each year and can be purchased online at www.arkansasrazorbacks.com or by calling the Razorback Ticket Center at 479-575-5151 or emailing raztk@uark.edu

- Total priority points
- Availability in each parking lot
- To retain your Women's Basketball parking pass(es), you must meet or exceed the annual fund contribution you were donating when you acquired your parking passes.
- Members are eligible for one (1) parking pass for every five (5) season tickets purchased, up to the maximum pass limits listed below for each membership level based on their membership level and total quantity of season tickets.

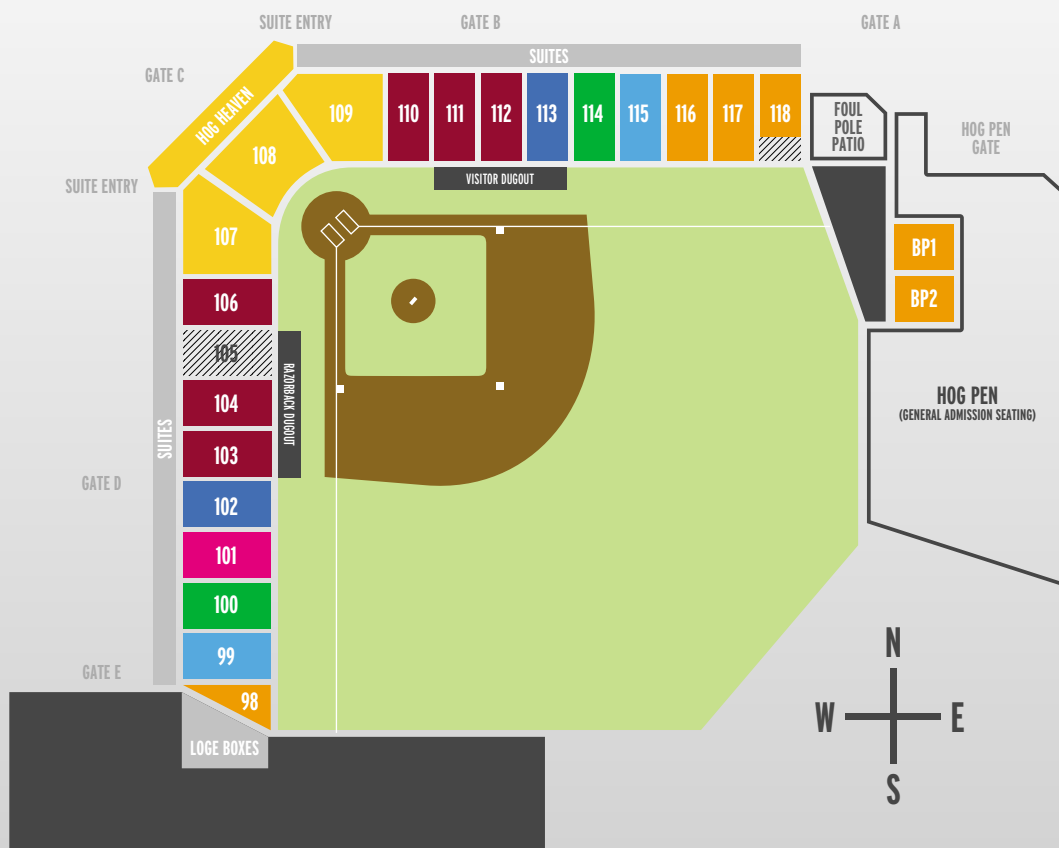
SEASON TICKETS

- The best opportunity to move current seat locations or purchase new Baseball season tickets is during the annual online selection process that takes place each December.
- All current Razorback Foundation members will receive their assigned selection time, which is based on their annual fund membership level and points, via email prior to the start of the process.
- Baseball season tickets are eligible for renewal each year. The process tentatively takes place annually in October.
- To retain Baseball season ticket locations, existing season ticket holders must maintain or exceed the previous year's total Annual Fund contribution, regardless of seat location or the number of tickets purchased.

POST-SEASON TICKETS

- In seasons when Baum-Walker Stadium is selected as a host site for NCAA Regionals or Super Regionals, season ticket holders will have the opportunity to request their seat locations for these series.
- Per NCAA ticket guidelines, we are required to give an allotment of tickets in specific sections to visiting teams participating in the Regional or super Regional, season ticket holders who have seats located in sections 113 and/or 114 will be displaced and moved to the next best available location in Baum-Walker Stadium.
- Any season ticket holder whose request is fulfilled for post season games will be required to pay the ticket price set by the NCAA for those tickets.

Baum-Walker Stadium has 34 suites that are sold on a full season basis only to Razorback Foundation members.

- Cost of suite tickets vary by the location and size of each suite.
- Suites are allocated as availability allows on a year-to-year basis by Razorback Foundation membership level and priority point ranking to eligible members on a wait list.



LOGE BOXES

Loge Boxes provide fans with a semi-private seating experience without missing any of the in-game excitement.

- There are 14 loge boxes inside Baum-Walker Stadium, located in the right-field corner.
- Each loge box comes with four (4) seats, a small tv, and a small fridge.
- Loge Boxes are allocated as availability allows on a year to year basis by Razorback Foundation membership level and priority point ranking to members on a wait list.

BASEBALL PARKING

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR BASEBALL PARKING

- Be a current Baseball season ticket holder
- Donate \$100.00 or more annually to the Razorback Foundation annual fund.

PARKING PASS ALLOCATIONS

Parking is allocated by the Razorback Foundation staff and is based on:

- Razorback Foundation annual fund membership level
- Total priority points
- Availability in each parking lot

MINIMUM MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Cardinal Lot:

Broyles-Matthews Silver (\$5,000+)

Baum-Walker East Lot:

Big Red (\$100+)

To retain your Baseball parking pass(es), you must meet or exceed the annual fund contribution you were donating when you acquired your parking passes.

PARKING PASS LIMITS:

Members are eligible for one (1) parking pass for every five (5) season tickets purchased, up to the maximum pass limits listed below for each membership level based on their membership level and total quantity of season tickets.

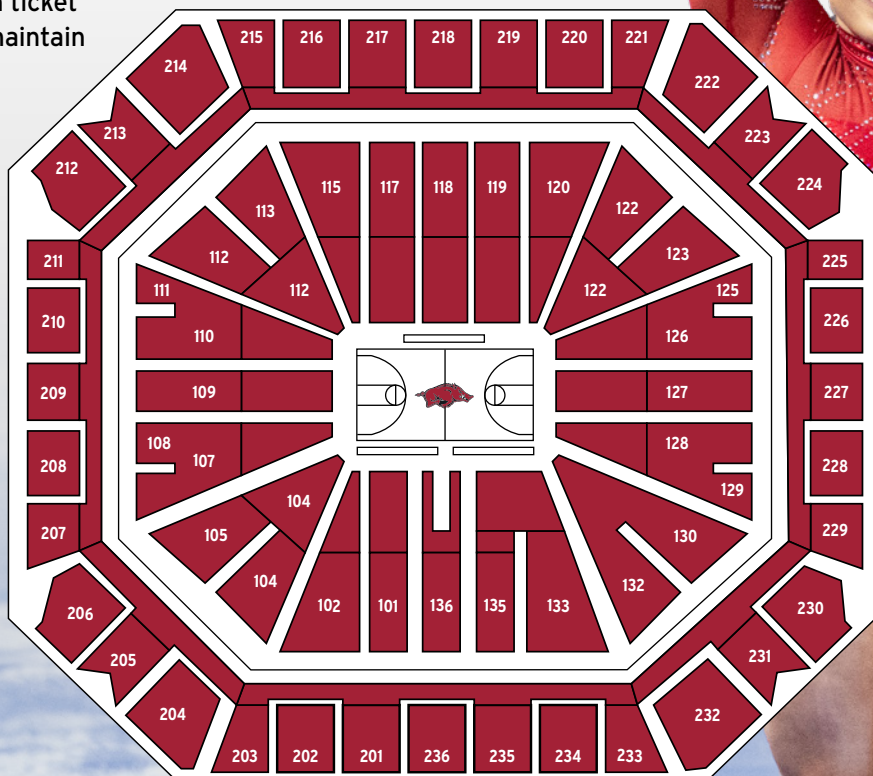

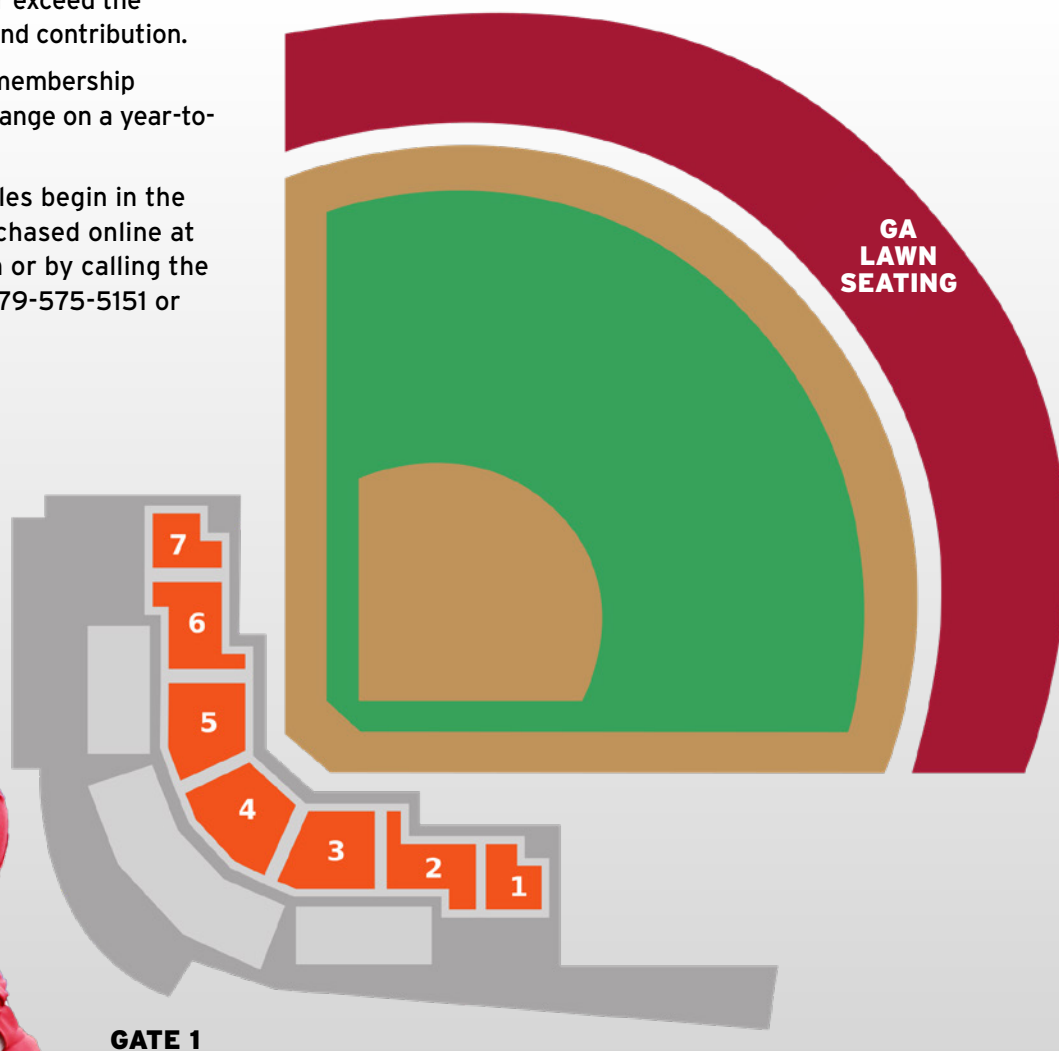
